PURPOSE OF THE ROLE:

- Ability to repair and maintain a wide range of drill rigs machines.
- Ability to troubleshoot all Mechanical failure, Hydraulic system related faults and maintain equipment to (OEM) original equipment manufacturers specification.

- Drill specialists are responsible for the troubleshooting, maintenance and performance optimization of Sandvik DI560 and DP1500 drill rigs. The role ensures high equipment availability and compliance with site safety standards while supporting production targets.
- Drill Mechanic are responsible for the troubleshooting, maintenance and performance optimization of Sandvik Di560 and DP1500i drill rigs. The role ensures high equipment availability and compliance with site safety standards while supporting production targets.
- Carry out daily, weekly and periodic inspection of the drill rigs.
- Diagnose and troubleshoot faults related to engine, compressor, hydraulic system, CAN bus and control system.
- Coordinate with maintenance teams and OEM support for major repairs and breakdowns.
- Carry out daily, weekly and periodic inspection of the rigs.
- Perform basic mechanical, hydraulic, pneumatic and electrical checks.
- Ability to read and interpret fault codes, manuals and technical drawings. Strong problem solving and communication skills.
- Coordinate with operations, planning and maintenance team to improve machine performance
- Ability to diagnose Caterpillar equipment with ET (Electronic Technician) tool.
- Observe all safety requirements relevant to the job in hand.
- Report to Supervisor any unsafe equipment immediately.
- Ensure that the work is performed to the OEM'S requirements, and that best fitment and installation practices are adhered to and impacted to the workforce.
- Conduct inspection of equipment's for damages or defect and records findings.
- Be able to plan work before execution.
- Always maintain housekeeping standards.
- Carry out work as required or directed.
- Repair equipment and report completion of tasks to Supervisor.
